Write out a grocery list, check Save On Foods website (see [mrshoveling.ca](http://mrshoveling.ca) for website - use this one as not all stores carry same items) to see if ingredients can be purchased there.

You may choose how to hand in your project in whatever format you choose - Google Slides, Google Docs, PowerPoint, Poster etc. Make sure you check the attached checklist and rubric to make sure you have handed in all required information.
